## ARDETH L DOTSETH

Ardeth Iola (Diggins) Listul Dotseth was born January 4, 1919 in Friendship Township, rural Clarkfield, MN to parents Tom and Eva (Benage) Diggins. Ardeth attended Clarkfield School.
